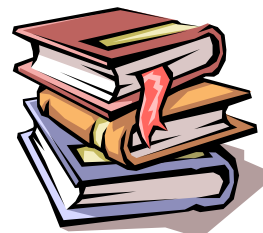

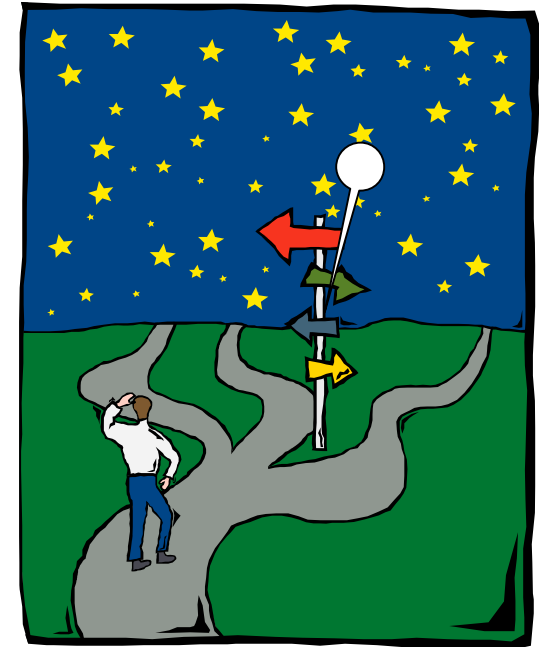

## Personal/Social Development

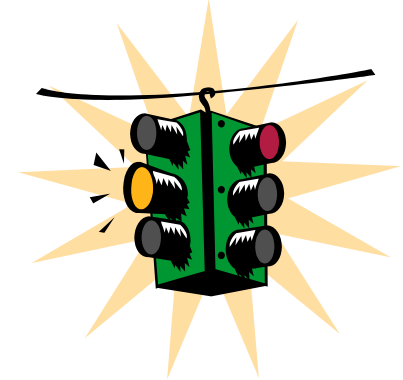
Equipping students with the skills, attitudes, and knowledge which help students respect self and others
